Requirements to participate in the call:

- Have Spanish nationality or work permit, or some other nationality that allows access to public sector employment. If you do not have it and this person is selected, the contract will not be formalized until the corresponding documentation is in order. In the event that this procedure is not finally completed within two months of the grant the selected person cannot be hired; leaving, in this case, the square deserted or referred to the next person in the event that priority order has been given in the Resolution.
- Be 16 years old and not exceed, where applicable, the maximum age of forced retirement or the other age that you may establish by law.
- The applicant will be bound by TEMPORARY WORK AGREEMENT with the Foundation for Health Research of the University Hospital and La Fe Polytechnic for the period determined for the research project. This procurement is subject to the granting of the relevant administrative authorisation.

Research Project Title: TARGETED OXYGENATION IN THE RESPIRATORY CARE OF PREMATURE INFANTS AT DELIVERY: EFFECTS ON OUTCOME (TORPIDO 30/60)

Oxygen is essential, but too much or too little are injurious. Preterm babies' ability to cope with excess oxygen is limited (causing oxidative stress or cerebral ischaemia), they usually need added oxygen at birth as their lungs are immature. The general aim is to compare outcomes of preterm infants up to 28+6 weeks gestation who have had respiratory care in the delivery room with (A) Initial FiO₂ 0.6 versus (B) Initial FiO₂ 0.3, followed by common SpO₂ targeting until admission to NICU.

The Population of this Clinical Trial are preterm infants between 23+0 and 28+6 weeks of gestation.

The Design of the Clinical Trial is Randomised controlled, phase III, stratified by (i) site (ii) gestation (iii) multiplicity Patients are randomly allocated to one of 2 arms:

- (A) Initial FiO₂ 0.60
- (B) Initial FiO₂ 0.30

- Verify that the data is real and protect patient safety.
- Be the communication link between the different research teams and the Promoter.
